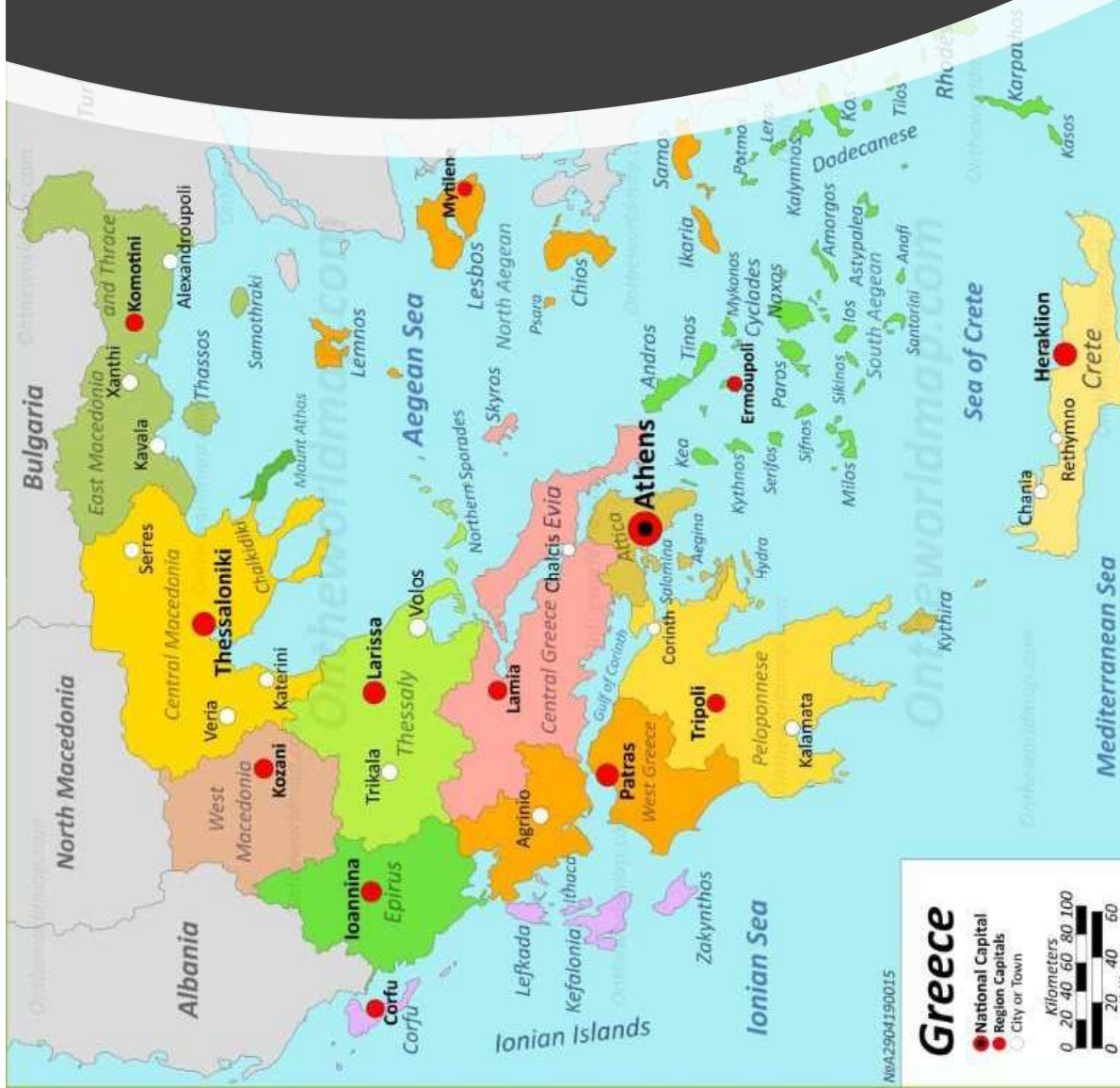

- Located in Southeastern Europe
- Seas: Aegean Sea, Ionian Sea, and the Mediterranean Sea,
- Borders: Turkey, Albania, N. Mace & Bulgaria
- Time: +3 UTC – 7 hr ahead of EST
- 13 Regions & 1 autonomous monastic state
- Gained independence from Ottoman Empire in 1830

- **Capital: Athens- Area: 81,990 sqm – slightly smaller than Alabama**
- **Land boundary 690M – Coastline 8,498M**
- **Chief: President – Head of Govt.: Prime Minister**
- **Climate: temperate; mild, wet winters; hot, dry summers**
- **Natural Resources: Lignite, petroleum, iron ore, bauxite, lead, zinc, nickel, magnesite, marble**
- **Population: 11 mn**
- **GDP: 314bn – Per Capita Income: \$29,500**
- **Off. Lang.: Greek – English widely spoken**
- **Religion: Greek Orthodox 90%, Muslim 2%, other 3%**
- **Currency: Euro**

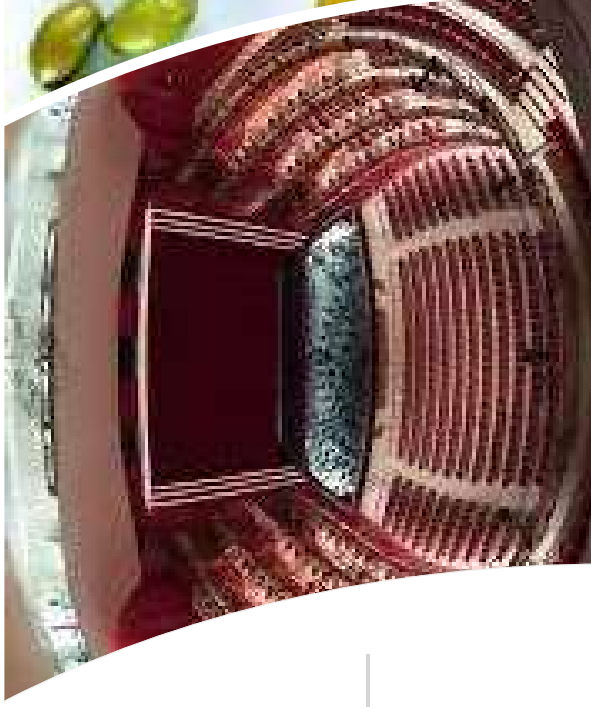
Greece – Interesting Facts

- **18 UNESCO World Heritage Sites: Acropolis, Temple of Apollo, Meteora, & Town of Corfu**
- **80% is made up of mountains**
- **No part is more than 85 M away from ocean**
- **More tourists visit than the population – 36mn in 2024 – 20% GDP from tourism**
- **Capital is named after the goddess Athena**
